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PRE-CLINIC ASSIGNMENT

****Please answer all questions by providing the rule reference and page number. Please bring the completed assignment to your clinic. (SRD = State Referee's Decision)**

1. A player who is about to come on the ice plays the puck with his stick. This player has either one or both skates still on the bench. What penalty is assessed? SRD
2. What is the maximum number of times that a goaltender is allowed to strike each pad to bring them into proper alignment before any measurement of the pads is taken? SRD
3. On a penalty shot, while going in on the goal, the player loses control of the puck or over skates it, forcing him to go back, retrieve the puck and then make his play on the goal. Is this legal? SRD
4. What penalty is assessed when a player grabs an opponent's hair, facial protector, helmet, chinstrap or neck protector but does not use it to gain an advantage or to inflict punishment or injury? SRD
5. What arm does the official raise to indicate a delayed off-side? SRD
6. A defending player high sticks the puck in his defending zone and the puck deflects to his own goaltender or to a teammate. When is the play stopped? SRD
7. Any player or team official who engages in verbal taunts, insults or intimidation based on discriminatory grounds (race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, and language) shall be assessed what? SRD
8. What penalty is assessed to a goaltender who, while outside his crease, deliberately falls on or gathers the puck into his body or holds or places the puck against any part of the goal, thus delaying the game unnecessarily? SRD
9. When a team is withdrawn from the ice and such team after being ordered to return, does return to start play, the referee would do what? SRD
10. A goaltender may not go to the players' bench during a stoppage of play for a replacement of his stick, but must receive his stick from a teammate. A violation of this rule would result in the goaltender receiving what?:
11. What penalty shall be assessed to a goaltender that shoots or hits the puck directly out of the playing surface above the glass with his stick? SRD
12. Would a minor penalty for having delayed the game be assessed to any Captain, alternate Captain or other player who leaves his players' bench to discuss any interpretation of the rules with the referee? SRD





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13. Team "A" player hits the puck with a stick above the normal height of the shoulders. The puck deflects off a player from Team "B" into the Team "A" net. Does the referee allow the goal? SRD
14. The Referee has signaled a delayed Minor penalty on Team "A". Team "B" has possession of the puck in its defending zone. A player on Team "A" stick checks the puck carrier resulting in the puck being directed into the net of Team "B". The Referee shall...: SRD
15. The puck is batted with the hand, hits the opposing goaltender, rebounds back out and is picked up by another player on the same team that originally batted the puck. The referee shall...: SRD
16. The Timekeeper reports that a penalized player's name and number are not listed on the game sheet. What determines if the player is eligible or ineligible to play? SRD
17. The goaltender from Team "A" is injured and Team "A" does not have an alternate goaltender dressed. How long may the game be delayed to allow the goaltender from Team "A" to recuperate? SRD
18. Minor hockey player A3 is on the ice without a throat protector while the game is in progress. This is the first such offence by the offending team. Two stoppages of play later, player A6 participates in the play after losing his throat protector. SRD

19. Describe the "release" signal which is used to transfer responsibility for coverage of a blue line from one linesman to the other:
20. A puck shot towards the goal hits a portion of an attacking player's broken stick which is lying on the ice and then goes directly into the net. Goal or no goal?
21. The Timekeeper does not inform the Referee that player A3 has received a third stick infraction penalty and A3 remains in the game after serving the penalty. What happens to any goals scored or assisted by A3 after the third stick infraction is assessed if this oversight is detected before the end of the game? SRD
22. A player gets into a fight but his opponent turtles and does not fight back. What penalty is he assessed? SRD
23. The captain of Team "A" approaches the referee and asks him to check to see if the goaltender of Team "B" has painted his CSA approved combination mask or to check it for decals. What is the referee's decision?





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24. A coach has received a bench minor for disputing a call and he continues this dispute. His language, gestures, etc. are not a problem; he just won't quit his dispute. What's the call?
25. Where must you conduct any and all equipment measurements in your Hockey game?
